TREASURER'S REPORT: As of October 21, 2019, the checking account balance was \$99,592.84. We had a bank transfer of \$12,890.28 from Tri-Beach Account which brought the balance to \$112,483.12. We had 2 disbursements, the first one was to Robinson & Cole for \$25,264.19 and the second one was to Fuss & O'Neill for \$22,120.36, which left a balance as of November 25, 2019, of \$65,098.57.

For the Tri-Beach Infrastructure Share Account, the checking account balance was \$41,272.19. We had a deposit from the State of CT for \$68.114.72, which left a balance of \$109,386.91. We had 2 disbursements, the first one was a bank transfer to WPCA for \$12,890.28 and the second one was to Fuss & O'Neill for \$40,272.18, which left a balance of \$56,224.45 as of November 25, 2019.

A motion to accept the Treasurer's report was made by Bob Asal and 2nd by Frank Nicotera. No discussion, none opposed, motion passed.

DISCUSSION ON BENEFIT ASSESSMENT: We discussed the idea of doing the Benefit Assessment based on the number of single structures in our association. We also have condos to consider and multiple structures as well. We are still working on coming up with a fair and equitable way to charge for the sewer project and we will discuss more options at our next meeting in January, 2020.
