# 7.4 PALM TREES ON THE BEACH- The Association will allow the planting of palm trees on Association beach property under the following conditions. Ordinance passed at the May 8, 2024 Board of Governors meeting

- The palm trees will be the responsibility of the property owner.
- The palm tree must be temporary, between the months of May October of each year. The palm trees and anything associated with the palm tree must be removed no later than November 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
- The property owner will attempt to place the palm tree on private property. If there are physical obstructions preventing the planting of palm trees on private property, the trees may be placed no greater than five feet onto Association beach property.
- The property owner will fill out a palm tree application form and receive approval before any planting of a palm tree on the beach.
- The penalties for Palm Tree plantings on Association property are:
  - \$50.00 fine for not submitting a palm tree application and receiving approval before the planting of a palm tree.
  - \$100.00 fine for not removing the palm tree and associated equipment by November 1st.

#### Voting Items for June 15, 2024, General Membership Meeting

➤OCBCA Charter Section 9 & Bylaws Article VIII Section 1- states the Board of Governors shall prepare and submit to said association, at the June Semi-annual meeting, a budget and recommend a tax for the purpose of and based on such budget. The Board of Governors will set the mill rate on the dollar of the total value of real estate within the limits of said association as shown by the last-completed grand list of the town of Old Lyme.

The Board of Governors is recommending approving the July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025, budget at \$232,100.00 and setting the mil rate at 4.0.

Motion to ban smoking on the beach- A motion to direct the Board of Governors to enact an ordinance to ban smoking on the beach to include all smoking material, marijuana, and all vaping devices.

#### **WPCA Costs of Project**

- Internal costs for Old Colony Beach Club Association (OCBCA)
  - Construction costs
  - Based upon bids
  - Including contingency and design costs (Fuss & O'Neill)
- Shared Costs
  - Construction costs Force main (Route 156), pump station, shoreline trunk including contingency and design costs
  - Costs for "tie-ins" to existing systems (East Lyme, Waterford & New London)
  - Costs will be shared with Old Lyme Shores, Miami Beach and Town of Old Lyme (Sound View)

### **How Will Project Be Funded?**

- Grant from Clean Water Fund 25% of costs
- Forgivable loan from State of Connecticut 25% of costs
- Loan 20 years at 2% interest
- Homeowners assessment for loan repayment
  - Will be assessed based upon equivalent dwelling units (EDU)
  - Assessment will be for 20 years
- Note Cost from house to curbside will be homeowners responsibility
- Note To keep the project progressing, OCBCA will take responsibility for the shared costs and be reimbursed by the other three stakeholders (Miami Beach, Old Lyme Shores, and Town of Old Lyme – through the Cost Sharing Agreement (CSA))
